I counted the students from each program's graduate students' page (usually listed under 'people') during the spring of 2013. Some programs do not have pictures listed. In those cases I made my best guess based on either the name or other indications such as 'she' or 'he', if available. Individual programs themselves should have accurate information in cases of mistakes. I focused on Ph.D. students if the program distinguished between them and the MA students categorically (very rare). I checked ranked U.S. programs from the philosophical gourmet, plus UIUC due to extra space available in the table.
